## CITY OF NORTON ORDINANCE NO. 34-2010

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A  
CONTRACT WITH ORIANA HOUSE, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. provides work release services to the Barberton Municipal Court, which handles Norton cases from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. has submitted a new contract for approval for the year 2010.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norton, Counties of Summit and Wayne and State of Ohio:

- Section 1: The Mayor is authorized and directed to renew an Agreement with Oriana House, Inc. to provide Community Correctional Services, in accordance with the updated rates and terms for 2010 on file with the Mayor's office and incorporated fully herein by reference and attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "A"**.
- Section 2: That the Finance Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make payment on the subject contract on presentation of proper vouchers from the appropriate account(s).
- Section 3: All formal actions of this Council related to this Ordinance and all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the city of Norton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the approval of 2010 rates and terms for services from the Oriana House should be in place as soon as possible to obtain the needed services at the costs quoted, and, provided it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
