AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 408.04 TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTON, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norton, Summit and Wayne Counties, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1: Section 408.04 shall be added to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Norton to read as shown on **Exhibit A** attached hereto.
- Section 2: All formal actions of this Council related to this Ordinance and all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

EXHIBIT A

408.04 PARKING VIOLATION FINES.

Unless otherwise provided in Chapters 452 and 454, whoever violates any provision of this Traffic Code relating to the parking of motor vehicles shall pay fines as follows:

452.03(a)(4)

Prohibited parking places/fire hydrant

\$95 if paid within 24 hours of occurrence, \$125 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$150

454.04

Fire lane

\$95 if paid within 24 hours of occurrence, \$125 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$150

452.03(a)

Prohibited parking places (other than fire hydrants under 452.03(a)(4))

\$25 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$30

452.04(a) and (c)

Manner of parallel parking and angle parking

\$25 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$30

452.05

Abandoned motor vehicle

\$25 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$30

All other parking violations not listed or excluded herein

\$20 if paid within 72 hours of occurrence; otherwise \$25

The day the ticket is received, including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays shall not be included in the computation of hours.

If a person has received three (3) or more tickets which remain unpaid, an additional fine of five dollars (\$5.00) for each ticket shall be added to the fine.
