The Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority (SASWMA) is pleased to announce the opening of the Norton Recycling Drop-off Center. The recycling center is hosted by the City of Norton and is ready to accept Summit County's recyclables. The recycling drop-off center is located at 4060 Columbia Woods, Norton, Ohio – behind the administration building. To assist residents with separating recyclables from household trash, SASWMA providing fifty (50) indoor recycling containers to the first 50 Norton residents that are ready to recycle. Recycling containers can be obtained at the City of Norton's Administration building.

The City of Norton is thrilled to have the opportunity to conveniently recycle 24 hours 7 days a week. This drop-off center will give Summit County residents the opportunity to be a little more green by recycling their plastic bottles #1's and 2's, aluminum and steel cans, glass jars, newspapers, magazines, office paper, and junk mail. Remember, by recycling just one aluminum can, enough energy is saved to operate a television set for three hours.

"Recycling drop-offs provide opportunities for Summit County residents and businesses that do not have recycling services, to recycle," stated Yolanda Walker, executive director of SASWMA. "We are hoping that SASWMA recycling drop-off centers will increase Summit County resident's and businesses ability to recycle."
