Notice is hereby given that bids will be received electronically on www.bidexpresss.com, up to the hour of 11:00 AM, local time on the 4th day of December, 2020 and released electronically immediately following, for the following:

CITY OF NORTON – WOOSTER ROAD STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

The project will consist of the replacement of the existing storm sewer as shown in the attached plans. The work includes the removal of existing drainage structures, the adjustment or reconstruction of manholes and catch basins, grading, and installation of new drainage structures.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Summit County and the City of Norton, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614.644.2239.

No bidder shall be considered a competent and responsible bidder or eligible to be awarded the contract to which this Notice applies, if the bidder is listed on the Auditor of State's database as having a "Finding of Recovery" as that term is defined in O.R.C. 9.24.

The City of Norton reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities or irregularities in bidding.
