

CITY OF NORTON – 2021 ROAD PROGRAM

Notice is hereby given that bids will be received by the office of the Mayor of the City of Norton electronically at www.bidexpress.com, with bids opening at January 7, 2021 at 11:00 AM, for furnishing the labor and material required for the City of Norton's 2021 Road Program according to the plans, specifications, and estimates for such improvement. The project will consist of the improvement of eighteen roadway sections by resurfacing. Resurfacing of 1.5" surface and 1.5" intermediate or 0.5" leveling course will be conducted for each section. The work includes the reconstruction of existing roadway cross-slope to improve drainage characteristics, the adjustment or reconstruction of manholes and catch basins, and curb repairs. The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are available at www.bidexpress.com. Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Summit County and the City of Norton, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614.644.2239. No bidder shall be considered a competent and responsible bidder or eligible to be awarded the contract to which this Notice applies, if the bidder is listed on the Auditor of State's database as having a "Finding of Recovery" as that term is defined in O.R.C. 9.24. The City of Norton reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities or irregularities in bidding.
