Cart Placement Rules

Follow these simple steps to ensure your waste and recyclables are collected quickly and easily:

- ▶ All recycling and waste must be placed at the curb.
- ▶ On your scheduled day of service, place your carts at the curb no later than 6 a.m.
- ▶ Position your carts no further than 3 feet away from the road, with the handle facing toward your residence.
- ▶ Do not park your car in front of the carts.
- ▶ Position your carts 3 feet away from any obstacles, such as a mailbox or light pole.



- ▶ Place all recyclables inside your cart, and do not overfill the cart.
- ▶ Remove carts from the curb within 24 hours of collection.
- ▶ Please separate recycling and trash carts a minimum of 4 feet from each other.

Waste Rules

Non-Acceptable Waste Items

- ✗ Steel drums
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Pharmaceuticals
- ✗ Ashes
- ✗ Hazardous or bio-hazard material
- ✗ Paint and solvents or any other liquids
- ✗ Tires, lead-acid batteries and car parts
- ✗ Items more than 50 pounds

Recycling Rules

Non-Acceptable Recycling Items

- ✗ Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
- ✗ Containers with food and liquid residue remaining
- ✗ Pizza boxes and wet paper products
- ✗ Garden hoses
- ✗ Small appliances
- ✗ All metals, except for those identified as acceptable

Acceptable Recyclable Items

- ✓ Clean paper, cardboard (OCC) and newsprint
- ✓ Glass food and beverage containers (all colors)
- ✓ Rigid plastic food and beverage containers (#1 through #7)
- ✓ Steel, aluminum and bi-metal food and beverage containers
- ✓ Gable-top milk, gravy and soup cartons

All items should be rinsed and free of contaminants. If in doubt, please call **800.247.3644**.

Collection Schedule

CITY OF NORTON

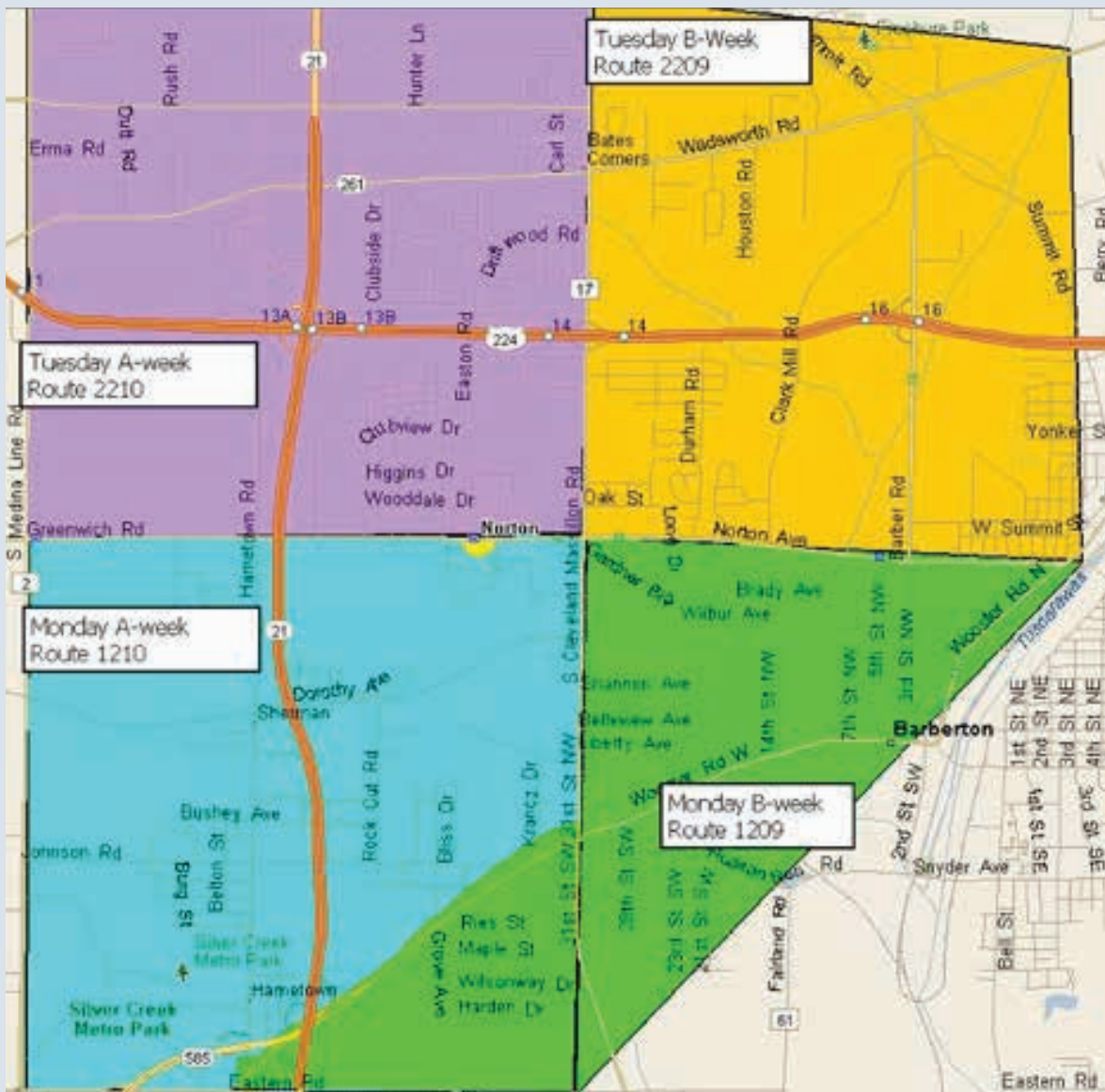
- ▶ All trash will be collected on Mondays and Tuesdays (see map).
- ▶ Recycling will be collected every other week, on the same day as trash collection.
- ▶ **Unlimited Service:** Residents will receive a 96-gallon trash cart and a 65-gallon recycling cart and are able to place an unlimited amount of weekly household trash at the curb along with an unlimited amount of recyclables. Senior citizens receive a 10% discount.
- ▶ **Limited Service:** Residents subscribing to this service will also receive a 96-gallon trash cart and a 65-gallon recycling cart. All material must fit “inside the cart” and any extra material placed outside the cart will be charged for the additional material (see extra charge schedule). Senior citizens receive a 10% discount.
- ▶ **Bag Service:** Residents who generate a minimal amount of weekly trash/recyclables can subscribe to the Bag Service. Any additional material that will not fit in the trash bags can be placed at the curb and will be charged to the resident according to the extra charge schedule. Bag Service customers will also receive a 65-gallon recycling cart for weekly collection.



Extra Charge Schedule for Limited and Bag Customers

Air conditioner (Freon removed)	\$5	Large truck tire	\$100
Air conditioner (Freon NOT removed)	\$55	Car/pickup truck tire	\$50
Box springs	\$5	*Mattress - full or twin	\$5
2-cubic-yard pile	\$25	*Mattress - king or queen	\$20
Carpet - each 4' length piece	\$5	Sink	\$5
Chair (upholstered)	\$10	Stove	\$5
Chair (wooden)	\$5	Television (small portables)	\$5
Couch	\$10	Toilet	\$5
Dishwasher	\$5	Tub	\$5
Refrigerator/freezer (Freon removed and tagged)	\$10	Water heater (water must be drained)	\$5
Refrigerator/freezer (Freon NOT removed)	\$75	Washer/dryer	\$5

- * Mattresses and box springs must be wrapped in plastic and sealed with tape.
- Freon-bearing appliances that have had Freon removed must be tagged by a certified technician.
 - No large flat-panel TVs will be collected. They must be taken to the designated electronic waste processor.



Carryout Service

- ▶ Residents who are physically unable to transport the recycling and trash carts to the curb can sign up for Carryout Service. Your trash and recyclables will be collected beside your house or garage each week at no additional charge. There can be no person(s) living in the home capable of transporting the recycling and trash to the curb, and a medical waiver must be approved with the City prior to obtaining the Carryout Service.
- ▶ All residents on Carryout Service will receive the Limited Service only and must still place bulk items and yard waste at the curb.
- ▶ Christmas tree collection will be provided at the curb the first 2 weeks following Christmas.
